Rochon Genova LLP is currently investigating a tragic plane crash that took the lives of 5 Ontarians in Nashville on the evening of March 4, 2024.

March 7, 2024 - Victor and Rimma Dotsenko of King Township, as well as their three children, died when their single-engine plane crashed alongside a highway west of downtown Nashville. The family was en route from Mount Sterling, Kentucky to Nashville, Tennessee at the time. The control tower at John C. Tune Airport received a message from Victor, the pilot of the Piper PA-32RT-300T Turbo Lance II, saying that the aircraft was experiencing engine and power failure and needed an emergency landing. The pilot then radioed and reported that they would not make it to the airport before the plane crashed.

The National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) are investigating the accident. The Transportation Safety Board of Canada said it has assigned a representative to the U.S.-led investigation.
